LOS ANGELES CHAPTER #42 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Los Angeles Chapter #42 of the National Association of Women in Construction annually awards one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. The scholarship is awarded to a student pursuing a degree leading to a career in construction. Such degree shall be in construction, civil, structural, mechanical, or electrical engineering, architecture or other construction related courses of study.

All applicants must have a minimum 3.0 (or equivalent) grade point average.

The scholarship will be granted to a student attending any accredited College or University in Los Angeles County. The scholarship grant shall be applied towards the cost of tuition and/or course expenses as selected by the recipient.

The Los Angeles Chapter #42 Scholarship Committee will review all applications. A complete application and current official academic transcript must be received no later than the stated deadline on the application. Applications received after the stated deadline will not be considered. The Board of Directors will approve a recipient no later than the May Board Meeting and the recipient will be promptly notified of the award.

Scholarships are not automatically renewed. However, receipt of a scholarship does not preclude a recipient from reapplying annually. Scholarship recipient(s) are encouraged to maintain contact with the Los Angeles Chapter #42 throughout the year and when possible attend monthly meetings.
